
Tech-Savvy Tactics

A leader in breast-related surgeries, Dr. Bengtson uses advanced techniques to ensure the best possible results for his patients. "I feel fortunate to be involved in some of the most exciting things happening in plastic surgery," he says. When consulting with a breast augmentation candidate, Dr. Bengtson uses strict tissue-planning principles, which take the patient's breast base width, skin elasticity and individual frame and shape all into account during the implant selection process. Combined with the Vectra® 3D Imaging System, which simulates results, this method gives patients the utmost confidence in the final outcome. Even in breast revision or reconstruction surgeries, Dr. Bengtson can incorporate technology such as the Strattice™ or Alloderm® tissue matrices, layers of tissue that act as internal reinforcements to better define breast shape and reduce the appearance of wrinkles or rippling.



LASER LIPOSUCTION

The SlimLipo™ procedure now offered by Dr. Bengtson provides results that are effective. "The experience is much better for the patient," Dr. Bengtson says. "I feel there is less tissue trauma and bleeding, and a faster recovery." The results come from the laser's two different wavelengths. The first accurately targets fat cells to melt them and make for easier removal, and the second causes an active skin contraction for active skin tightening. "It's like a heat-seeking missile. It goes in and destroys fat cells more uniformly."



RESTORATIVE REVISION

Breast revision surgery, Dr. Bengtson admits, is the most challenging procedure he does in breast surgery. One of the tools in his arsenal that improves the chances of success is the acellular dermal matrix, which also goes by Strattice™. (Its cousin, Alloderm®, aids in breast reconstruction surgery.) This layer of tissue helps to control the breast location, hold the implant in place and prevent future drooping. "It's essentially a sheet of collagen and proteins that can help support an implant," says Dr. Bengtson. "This can help even challenging revision patients achieve their aesthetic goals."
